Parnian 3 quick user guide for  
Freehand, QuarkXPress and Photoshop  
Macintosh and Windows

# Introduction

"Parnian 3" is a set of powerful tools which, designed for both "Windows" and "Macintosh" systems. By using "Parnian 3" you can type directly in the most graphic softwares, import Arabic software files like "MS-Word" in to some graphical software like "Freehand", "QuarkXPress", "Photoshop" without any changes in their attributes, and impose database files like "Fox-Pro" automatically. "Parnian 3" provides many different and powerful tools for professional and nonprofessional users easily.

"Parnian 3" features are categorized in to groups:

The first group includes the tools those are designed especially for "Freehand", "Photoshop", etc...

"Parnian 3" adds many choices and interfaces to the mentioned softwares and with the aid of these tools you can import Arabic files produced by Arabic softwares like "Microsoft Word" and "RTF" with all their attributes, then edit and correct them, and typically now you can have everything for Arabic that you had it before for Latin.

The second group refers to the public "Parnian 3" tools those let you to convert other software files to each other with all their major attributes. By using "Parnian 3" public features you can type in Arabic language directly in the software that we haven't produced any special feature for that. (Like Adobe Photoshop Element, Premier...)

# How to use this book

This book is a quick guide for introducing "Parnian 3". In this book we try to explain using "Parnian 3" in different programs as easiest as possible. In this book you can not find any detail or technical notes. For more information and complete reference about using "Parnian 3" you should read "User guide" which exist on the "Parnian 3" CD-ROM.

For troubleshooting you can read the appendix of "User Guide" which is available on "Parnian 3" CD-ROM for first step, If you didn't find any suitable solution for you problem then you can try <http://www.parniansoft.com> web site and read the Q&A section for second step. and finally If you haven't satisfied yet you can contact to Parniansoft after sale service department by sending an email to [support@parniansoft.com](mailto:support@parniansoft.com) or making a phone call to +98(21)8317355-6, +98(21)8314795-6

# Installation

Windows/Macintosh

1. If you are intend to use “Parnian 3” in Photoshop, Freehand and QuarkXPress and...,
  - then you have to make sure that the mentioned softwares are installed properly.

2. Make sure that you are Admin equivalent user if you are installing on Windows 2000 or XP.

Make sure that you have read/write permission in Application folder and also in Freehand, Photoshop... folders, if you are installing on Macintosh OSX.

3. Insert “Parnian 3” CD-ROM into your CD-ROM drive.

4. In windows: If the installation process doesn't start automatically, then you should run
  - “**Parnian Installer**” from the root directory of your CD-ROM.

In Macintosh run “**Parnian Setup**” Program.

5. Follow the instruction on your screen.

6. Reboot your computer when the installation
  - completed.

# Using in Freehand

Windows/Macintosh

## Create Arabic Text box

To type Arabic you need to create Arabic text box first. To creating Arabic text box press RTL paragraph button, which is located on **Parnian Navigator** window. If you can not see this window, then you should click on **Xtras** menu then click on **Parnian** finally click on **Navigator**.

Now specify an area by using the Freehand Textbox tool.

For changing between Arabic and Latin languages in Windows use the key combination: Ctrl+Win+Alt+Space



(or simply press Scroll lock if you are sure that it is not used by any other software) and in Macintosh use key combination Ctrl+Cmd+Option+Space (or Cmd+Clear). For changing the font of a text in a Arabic Textbox use the font list Which is available in **Parnian Navigator**

## Keyboard layout

If you want to see keyboard layout use the Keyboard choice in Parnian section of Xtra menu.




# Importing text to Freehand


Windows/Macintosh

## Importing formatted text file to Freehand

First you need to draw an Arabic text box to import a formatted text file (like Microsoft word).


Then enter the text box by using the **A** tool, after that click on  from the Parnian Tools window to select your file to import.



If your selected file contains some unavailable fonts on your system, than Parnian will show a window for replacing suitable fonts instead of unavailable fonts. These replacements are valid just for current file. If you want to define a font replacement for later use then you will have to change Parnian importers setups. To change these setups click on  while pressing Option (Ctrl on windows).



## Exporting text from Freehand

You can export Arabic texts that you typed in Freehand to the format of other softwares like Microsoft word, HTML, etc. To do this first of all you need to enter the text box you are going to export its text, then click on  which exist in Parnian Tools+ after that specify exported file name.

# Arabic align in Freehand

Windows/Macintosh

## Arabic Alignment

To convert alignment from **Latin** to **Arabic** you need to use **Loose Repair** section in **Parnian Navigator** Window.


The **Repair** key converts **Latin** alignment to **Arabic** alignment using the items specified in **Element** and **Element** type.



Notice that the **Repair** key uses character spacing defined in **Freehand**. The **Undo** key revert the changes. (Convert **Arabic** alignment to **Latin** Alignment). The quick shortcut for converting **Latin** alignment to **Arabic** alignment is **Ctrl+Cmd+F10** (In windows **Ctrl+Alt+F10**).

To undo and revert changes use the **Ctrl+Cmd+F11** key sequence (In windows **Ctrl+Alt+F11**).

## Creating Arabic text box in Quark

For typing Arabic in Quark you need to draw an Arabic text box. To do this place the Right to Left paragraph key  from Parnian Tools window in pressed status.



Now define an area for typing using the Quark text box tool. For switching between Arabic and Latin languages in windows use the Ctrl+Alt+Space (Or use the Scroll Lock if you are sure that it is not used by any other

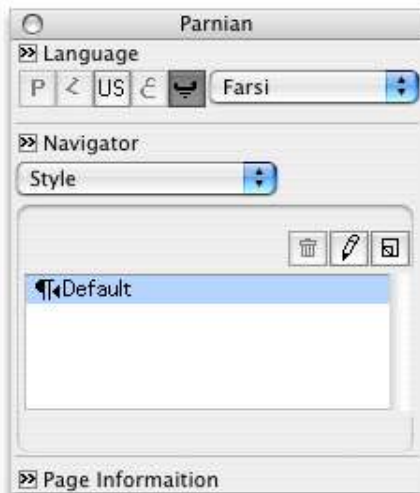
software), and in Macintosh use the Control+Option+Cmd+Space.

For changing the font of an Arabic text that you've typed it before in Arabic text box use the **Font** list and for changing the style use the **Style** section of the Parnian window.



## Creating style for Arabic/Latin typing

Parnian uses two character styles for typing in Arabic text boxes. The first style specifies Arabic typing method and the second style specifies the Latin typing method. The Style section of Parnian window offers some facilities for creating compound character styles to use in Arabic text boxes.



## Keyboard layout


You can use **Keyboard** from the **Parnian** menu to see the keyboard layout. You can change the keyboard layout by **Edit** button.

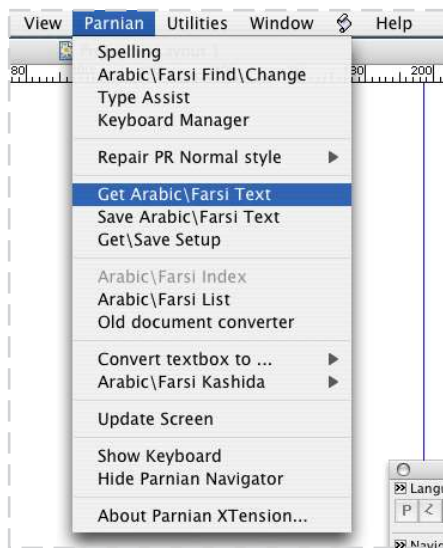



# Importing text files to Quark

Windows/Macintosh

## Importing text file

For importing an Arabic text file to Quark you need to draw an Arabic text box at first. Next press the  button in Parnian Tools window or choose Get Arabic/Farsi text from the Parnian menu for selecting your desired text file that you are going to import in to the Quark.



- If selected file contains some fonts those are not exist on your system then Parnian will show a dialog and lets you to specify a font instead of it. The replacement that you specify here is just for current file. If you want to specify a replacement for all files then you will have to change the Parnian Importer setups. To do this, click on  button while holding down Option key (Ctrl in windows) or choose Get/Save setup from Parnian menu.

## Exporting text to other softwares

- By using the Parnian facilities you can export Arabic text that you typed in Arabic text boxes to the other formats such as Microsoft Word etc.

- To do this you should enter the text box that contains the text you want to export. Then specify the filename by choosing the Save Arabic/Farsi text.

# Arabic align in Quark

Windows/Macintosh

## Arabic alignment

To convert alignment from **Latin** to **Arabic** you need to use **Kashida** section in **Parnian** Window. The **Add** key converts **Latin** alignment to **Arabic** alignment using the items specified in **Element** and **Element** type.



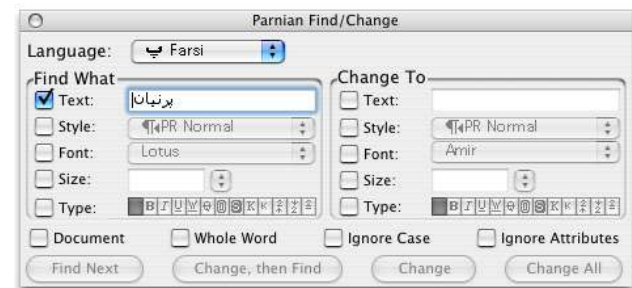
Notice that the **Add** key uses character and word spacing defined in **Quark** (H&J section). The **Remove** key revert the changes. (Convert **Arabic** alignment to **Latin** Alignment).

The quick shortcut for converting **Latin** alignment to **Arabic** alignment is **Control+Cmd+F** (In windows **Ctrl+Alt+U**).

To undo and revert changes use the **Ctrl+Cmd+R** key sequence (In windows **Ctrl+Alt+U**).

## Find and replace in Arabic texts


You should use Parnian text search tool to find and replace texts. To do this, choose the **Arabic/Farsi find** in **Parnian** menu.



# Typing in Photoshop

Windows/Macintosh


## Creating Arabic text layer


For creating Arabic text layer press the  button from the **Parnian** window, then start your typing in the window, which is shown (**Parnian Type Tools**) and finally press OK button.



One quick way for creating Arabic text layer is using the Cmd+F1 key sequence (in windows Ctrl+Shift+F1). By using this key sequence an Arabic text layer will be added to the current document.

## Editing Arabic text

For editing an Arabic text layer first you need to enter the text layer by using Photoshop text tool ( button). Then change the second Photoshop language to the state that you have created the layer.

Pressing the  button in **Parnian** window (or pressing the **Scroll lock** in windows or **Cmd+Clear** in Macintosh) will help you to edit your Arabic text in the current layer.




# Importing text file in Photoshop

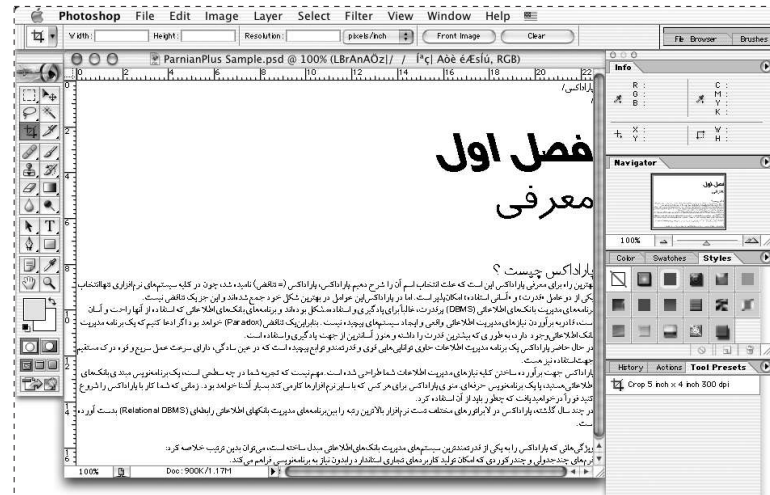

## Importing text file

For importing Arabic text file to Photoshop follow these steps.

- First of all make sure that you have selected the document you are going to import a file and you are not in editing text layer mode.
- Press  button from Parnian Tools+ window or in Macintosh use Cmd+F2 and in windows press Ctrl+Shift+F2.
- Choose your desired file using the Open dialog, which is appeared on your screen. If you can't see your file please select "All Files" from the File Type section.
- If Parnian has more than one Importer for your selected file (like .TXT file that may belongs to Arabic windows, Macintosh, Paradox...) or Parnian can not recognize your file automatically, then a window will be shown which its title is **Parnian Import** and asks you to choose the type of you file.

- If you choose a correct file type in previous step, then the text in the file will be imported to a new layer, which its size is equal to the current document.



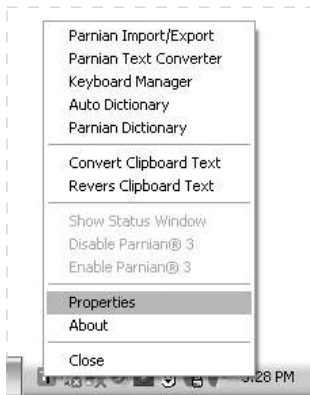
# Typing in other softwares

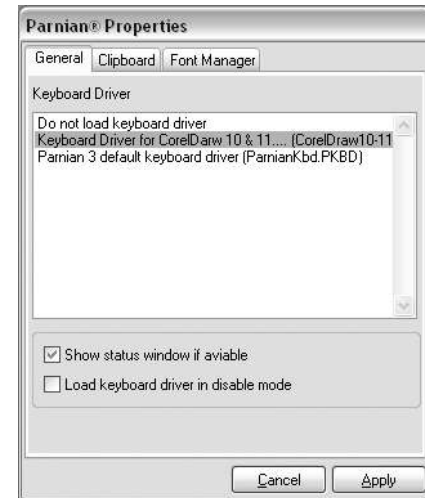
## Arabic typing

In windows if you need to type in English softwares like CorelDraw, After Effect, Photoshop Element, Premiere and etc, follow these steps:

- From the tray menu  (or **E**) choose **Properties**.





- In **Parnian Properties** window select a driver, which is compatible with the software you are going to type in it.



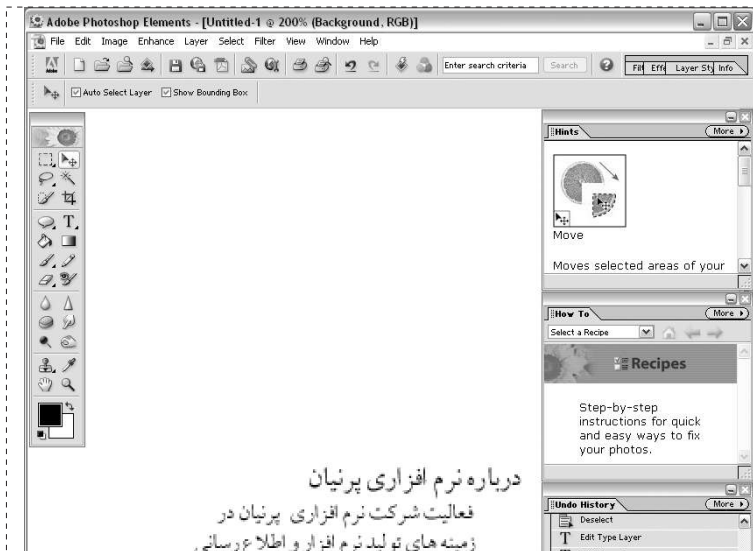
- Make sure that Parnian 3 direct type is enabled. (The **Enable Parnian@ 3** from the Parnian tray menu is disabled).
- Enter the type mode in the target software.
- Make sure that windows keyboard is in English mode.
- To change the Parnian keyboard from Latin to Arabic and vice versa use the **Scroll Lock**. The Parnian

icon in tray shows the current Parnian keyboard.  
The  icon is for Arabic and  is for Latin.


- Start your typing.

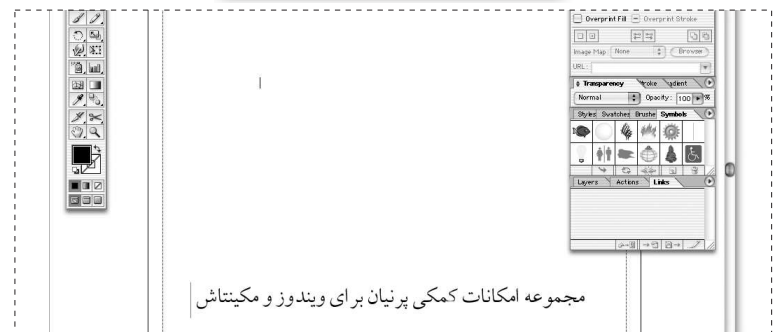


To use this facility in Macintosh:



- From the right mouse click menu or Control+mouse click menu choose **Parnian 3**.
- In **Parnian 3** section choose **Parnian Type Tool**.



- After you have done your typing in the **Parnian Type Tool** window press  button to send the text to clipboard and paste it in the target software.

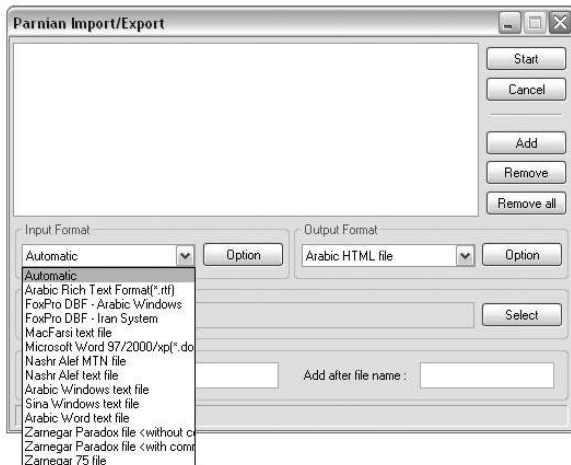


## Parnian 3 converter

If you want to move a file from one software to another (such as converting a file from Microsoft word for Windows to Arabic PageMaker for Macintosh) then you'll need to use **Parnian Import/Export** via the menu of Parnian tray icon  (or ) and in Macintosh you can use the **Parnian** from the right mouse click menu.

## Conversion steps

- From the menu of **Parnin3**, click on **Parnian Import/Export** choice.



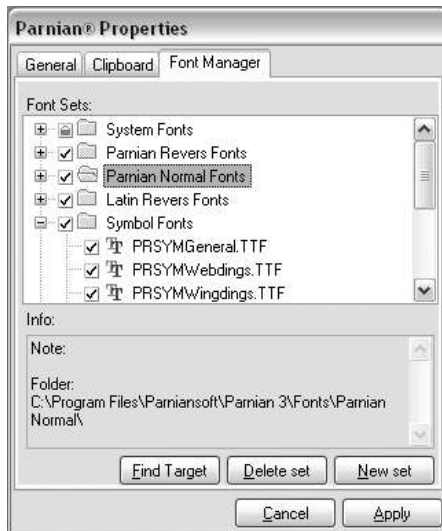
- Click on **Add** button.
- Select your file(s) via open dialog box, which will be popped up on your screen and then click on **Open** button.
- Select your file format from the **Input format** section. If you select **Automatic** choice and the **Parnian** can't recognize it automatically then your file format will be asked.
- For a file with the format, which does not exist in **Input Format** list you can use **Parnian Text Converter**. (For more information refer to **User guide** available in CD-ROM.
- In **Output Format** choose a format for your output file(s).
- Choose your destination for saving output file(s) by using the **Select** button.
- Push the **Start** button.



# Parnian Font Manager

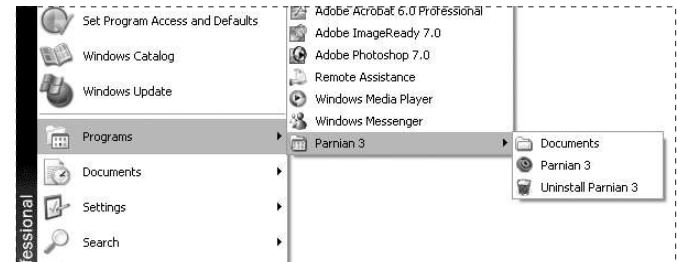

## Parnian Font Manager

Parnian 3 added its fonts to the Windows via Parnian Font Manager. Categorizing fonts in this program offers an easy way to add and remove fonts.



Necessary Arabic fonts for **Parnian 3** will be added to Windows only if **Parnian Font Manager** is executed. The existence of  icon (or ) in tray means that **Parnian Font Manager** has been executed before. If the mentioned icon does not exist, then you will have to choose **Parnian 3** program from the **Parnian 3** group in the **Start menu**.



In Macintosh for managing your fonts you should use your Font Book program.

# Parnian web site

You can use our web site to keep your **Parnian 3** software up to date. You can download latest Parnian 3 update, Filters, New fonts, additional guides and documents from Parnian web site (<http://www.parniansoft.com>) for free and add them to your **Parnian 3**.
